

## **Authority Of The Apostles Luke 22:24-30**

### **But Jesus Didn't Say It**

Hear this comment/excuse regarding many unrighteous deeds

Especially sexual immorality

Should we only be concerned with the "words in red"?

Did Jesus authorize others to teach all men?

Consider Apostolic Authority

### **They Were Sent**

Chosen by Jesus - **Luke 6:13; Mark 3:13-15; Acts 1:1-2**

Jesus sent the Apostles to speak God's Word to all men - **Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-16; Mark 16:20**

Not just to speak, but to command - **1Corinthians 14:37; Matthew 16:19; 18:18**

In receiving them, we receive Jesus and the Father - **2Corinthians 5:20; Ephesians 6:20; Matthew 10:40-41;**

**Luke 10:16; John 13:20; Galatians 2:6-9**

### **Appointed Eyewitnesses**

They were with Jesus - **Acts 1:21-26; 26:9-16**

They experienced His ministry and teaching - **1John 1:1-3; 2Peter 1:16-21; 1Corinthians 9:1; 15:4-9**

### **Instructed And Inspired**

Jesus taught them during His ministry - **Matthew 17:1-8; Luke 22:28-30; John 14:25-28; 16:12-13**

He sent to Spirit to further guide them - **John 14:16; 15:26-27**

They gave us the Word of God - **Acts 4:19-20; 1Corinthians 2:12-13; Luke 12:12; 2Timothy 3:16**

### **They Were Empowered**

Filled with the Spirit of God - **Luke 24:49-52; Acts 2:1-4**

Taught with authority - **Acts 4:13; 1John 2:24; 1Thessalonians 2:13; 1Peter 1:22-25**

### **Heed Their Message**

The Word of the Spirit should convict us - **John 16:8; 1John 2:7**

We should practice it - **Philippians 4:9; Acts 2:42**
